



What can I do with items FROM does not accept?

- **Metal Hangers**
 - Any nearby scrap yard, such as Padnos, Black River Recycling
- **Anything that's missing pieces**
 - Try contacting local schools for art projects or recycle based on materials
- **Stained or ripped items**
 - Stained or ripped clothing is accepted at all H&M stores
- **Large appliances (ex. water softeners & trash compactors)**
 - In The Image of Kalamazoo, Habitat for Humanity, Ronald McDonald House
- **Fabric furniture (ex. couches, chairs, etc.)**
 - Habitat for Humanity
- **Large exercise equipment (ex. treadmills & exercise bikes)**
 - Cascade Engineering
- **Organs & pianos**
 - Check with local schools and churches
- **TV's, computers, printers & typewriters**
 - Comprenew electronics recycling, Valley City Electronic recycling
- **Liquid heaters & air conditioners**
 - Salvation Army, Habitat for Humanity
- **Chemicals & Paint**
 - Ronald McDonald house will accept cleaning chemicals
 - Look for a Hazardous Waste collection event near you to dispose of paint
- **Mattresses & waterbeds**
 - Habitat for Humanity, Bibles for Mexico-No stains or rips
- **Any products that have been recalled**
 - Please contact the manufacturer or recycle based on materials
- **Baby Equipment & Furniture**
 - Baby Pantry of Lowell, Alpha Women's Center of Lowell, Bibles for Mexico, Once upon a child
- **Plastic grocery bags for reuse**
